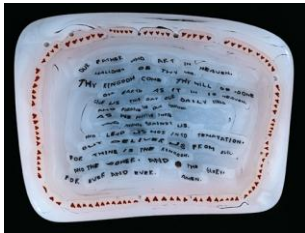

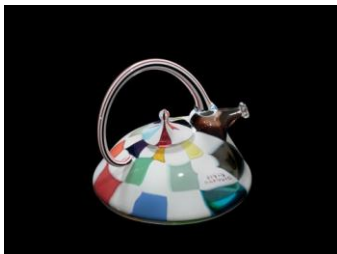

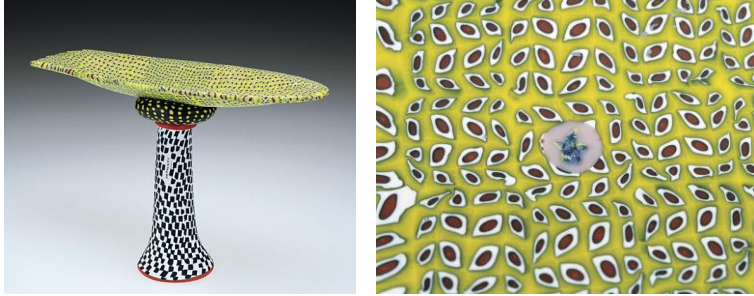

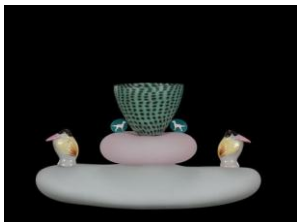

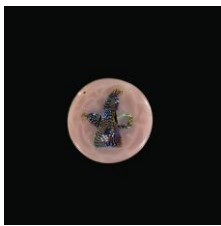

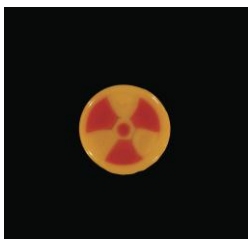

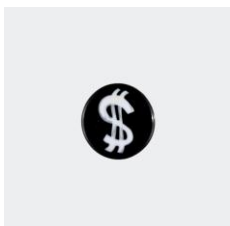

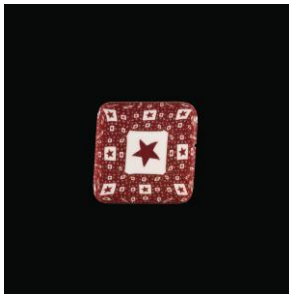
Murrina with Dollar Sign

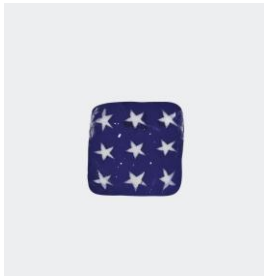

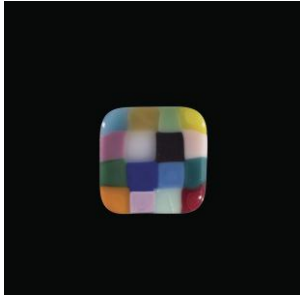

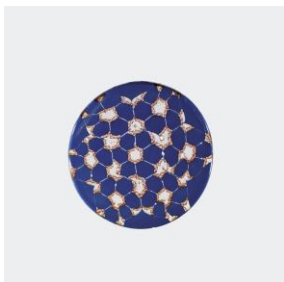
Murrina with Black Dots Outlined in White on Green

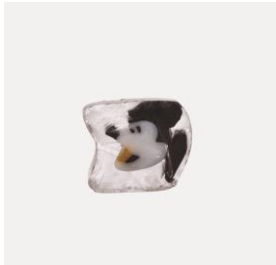
